Deadline to Apply for Scholarships is April 1, 2025

Farmers Mutual Telephone Cooperative of Shellsburg (d/b/a USA Communications) offers a college scholarship program to support the continuing education of high school seniors whose parents or legal guardians are members of the cooperative and have service in the Shellsburg, Benton Township, Urbana, or Alburnett exchange. Scholarships are awarded yearly to a minimum of two students in each of those four exchanges. The academic credentials of students must fall within an average to aboveaverage range to be eligible.

A League of Their Own (1992)

During World War II, sisters Dottie and Kit join the first female professional baseball league and struggle to help it succeed amid their own growing rivalry. Tom Hanks plays the crusty manager.

Moneyball (2011)

The movie about math and data in baseball has a cheerful love of the sport, too, and Brad Pitt and Jonah Hill are an oddly perfect team.

Major League (1989)

The new owner of the Cleveland Indians puts together a purposely horrible team so they'll lose, and she can move the team. But when the plot is uncovered, they start winning just to spite her.

Eight Men Out (1988)

A dramatization of the Black Sox scandal, the worst in baseball's history, when the underpaid Chicago White Sox accepted bribes to deliberately lose the 1919 World Series.

The Natural (1984)

A middle-aged unknown (Robert Redford) comes seemingly out of nowhere to become a legendary baseball player with almost supernatural talent.

Bull Durham (1988)

Watch it for the funny conversations on the mound, the tricks for getting out of a slump, and the romance between a baseball player (Kevin Costner) and fan (Susan Sarandon).
